

Job Descriptions - 2022

Requirements for all positions

- Putting your safety first
- Be Punctual and Professional
- Flexible-may be moved temporarily to scene as need arises
- Ability to work in all weather conditions (Rain, Heat & Cold)
- Cell phones are to be kept out of sight.
- No smoking while on duty on the property
- Be able to work independently and in the dark
- Be a part of the team
- Be able to follow specific instructions
- For some scenes maintain a small campfire, and extinguish it
- Be able to sit and/or stand for long periods of time
- Some technical experience for some scenes would be an asset
- Be able to scream/yell to scare people through entire shift
- Improvisational skills for some scenes is an asset

1) **AOT – Actor (Speaking Role)**

- Specific Costumes, Makeup, Hair and/or Masks will be required
- Previous acting experience for some scenes is an asset
- Be able to learn lines for a scene and able to project voice
- You must be comfortable talking for the whole shift
- Coordination and timing will be imperative
- Some positions require use of a harness and working at heights

2) **AOT – Actor (Screaming Role)**

- Specific Costumes, Makeup, Hair and/or Masks will be required
- This role includes Screaming, Yelling, Groaning but no Speaking
- Improvisational skills for some scenes is an asset
- Experience with Chainsaws and Small Power Tools is an asset
- Coordination and timing will be imperative
- Some positions require use of a harness and working at heights

3) **AOT - Scene Support**

- Coordination and timing will be imperative
- Lots of heavy pulling and lifting is required at some scenes
- Supply and wear black clothing head to toe

4) AOT - Narrator

- Bilingualism is an asset
- You must be comfortable standing on a moving wagon
- You must be comfortable talking for the whole shift
- Be able to improvise as needed and ready to tell jokes
- Be able to project voice on a moving wagon with tractor noise
- Specific Costumes and Makeup will be required
- Be able to learn & memorize a set of lines
- Be able to interact with customers on the wagon
- Be able to professionally interact with all customers at all times, including troublemakers
- You must remain in character at all times while on the property

5) AOT – Actor in Spooky Village (Speaking/Screaming Role)

- Specific Costumes, Makeup, Hair and/or Masks will be required
- Previous acting experience for some scenes is an asset
- Be able to learn lines for a scene and able to project voice
- You must be comfortable talking for the whole shift
- Be able to interact with customers in the village
- Improvisational skills for some scenes is an asset

6) AOT – Actor in Fog Maze (Screaming Role / Scene Support)

- Specific Costumes, Makeup, Hair and/or Masks will be required
- This role includes Screaming, Yelling, Groaning but no Speaking
- Be comfortable working indoors in a dimly-lit fog maze
- Coordination and timing will be imperative
- Some positions require use of a harness

7) Safety / Parking

- Greeting and directing guests arriving at the event
- Be comfortable working with crowds (crowd control)
- Be comfortable working outdoors in varying weather conditions
- Must be able to stand for extended periods of time
- Be able to professionally interact with all customers at all times, including troublemakers
- Helping to direct the flow of traffic
- Patrolling the parking lot and grounds to ensure everything is running smoothly
- Ensuring a safe and pleasant environment for the guests

Pay Information:

Acres of Terror (AOT) Staff will be paid in one lump sum in the middle of November. You must have a Social Insurance Number to be paid. If no SIN is available, we will hold your pay until you get your SIN number.

You will need to come to the orchard, in person, to collect your pay cheque. Pay cheques will not be given to parents or friends.
